ATTIKAMEK BIRCHBARK ROGANS



The Attikamek Birchbark Rogans are made from birchbark and tied with imitation sinew. They come in assorted designs. Most have moosehide straps and lids. The sizes listed here are somewhat standardized and are sold as assorted pieces. See our galleries on-line at www.naturalexotics.com for an assortment of unique pieces. DENE BIRCHBARK BOXES



113-203-AS

These birchbark boxes are handmade by the Slave Tribe in Fort Liard in the Northwest Territories. They are bound together with spruce roots on the lids and artificial sinew on the bottom, and are decorated with dyed porcupine quills on the lid only. They are tied with moose hide leather laces that may or may not be smoked.

The boxes may vary in size but they average about 2.5" high by 2.5" to 2.75" wide at the base, with a lid that measures between 2.75" to 3" wide. Lid decorations vary. Supplies are limited. (Porcupine Quills: *Erethizon dorsatum*; Birchbark: *Betula papyrifera*; Moose Laces: *Alces alces*)

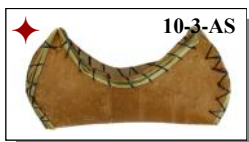

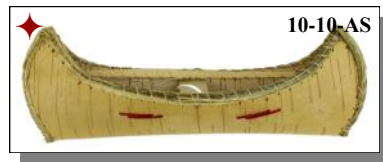
OJIBWA BIRCHBARK CANOES

The canoes are trimmed with sweetgrass and most of the larger sizes are also trimmed with porcupine quills. Most of the smaller sizes do not have porcupine quills. They are handmade so sizes given below are approximate and designs can vary depending on the artist. They are great for rustic or cottage décor and the smaller sizes also work well as Christmas ornaments if you attach thread or sinew. (Porcupine Quills: *Erethizon dorsatum*; Birchbark: *Betula papyrifera*; Sweetgrass: *Hierochloe odorata*).

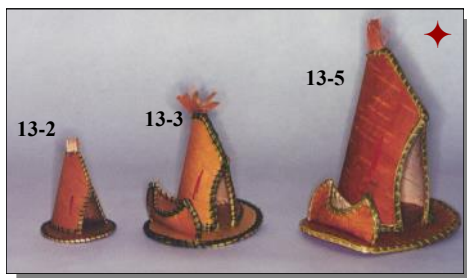

The Tee-Pees are trimmed with sweetgrass for a natural aroma and have porcupine quill decorations on the sides. The Tee-Pee Villages are trimmed with sweetgrass and are made using white birchbark. (Porcupine Quills: *Erethizon dorsatum*; Birchbark: *Betula papyrifera*; Sweetgrass: *Hierochloe odorata*).

1010-2 Sage and Sweetgrass

Sage comes in many varieties and is still used today in ceremonies, medicine, and cleansing.

It is burned in smudging ceremonies to ward off evil spirits, and to eliminate negative feelings and influences.

In Plains nations, sage is spread on the floor of the sweatlodge and participants rub the leaves onto their bodies to purify and protect themselves.

Sundancers wear wreaths made of sage to symbolize that their minds and hearts are close to the Great Spirit.

Blue sage is sold in 8" to 9" bundles and is ideal for use in smudging. It is not for human consumption. (*Artemisia tridentate, wild*).

California white sage is ideal for smudging ceremonies. The 6" to 7" and the 8" to 9" bundles may be individually bagged with a card attached. Our white sage is grown on Native American-owned farms and assembled into bundles by the Cherokee. Not for human consumption. (*Salvia apiana, wild*).

Indian sweetgrass is a rare grass which is found growing wild in very few places. It has a sweet fragrance of its own that stays with the grass forever.

When burned or dampened, the sweet scent of the grass is released into the air. Burning sweetgrass purifies the air, the mind, and one's thoughts.

When smoked in peace pipes, it is said to bring good luck and health. Prayers said into the sweetgrass smoke rise toward the clouds and are scattered by the winds into the heavens and the Great Spirit.
